Paki (noun – offensive British slang): a person from Asia, esp. Pakistan *Calling someone a Paki is extremely offensive.*

merc (verb – slang): to kill somebody *Give me your money or I'll merc ya!*

supposed (to be) (verb): meant (to be), intended (to be) *This letter was supposed to be sent to Australia, not Austria.*

suffer (verb): to feel pain, or to be badly affected by a situation *When the economy is bad, poor people usually suffer the most.*

fancy (verb – British informal): to feel like (having or doing) something *What do you fancy for dessert?*

Muslim (adjective): of, or related to, Islam *Indonesia has the biggest Muslim population in the world.*

Hindu (adjective): of, or related to, Hinduism *We saw lots of Hindu yogis and old Hindu temples in Varanasi.*

quid (noun – British informal): a pound (in British money) *A pint of beer costs four quid in that club!*

nigger (noun – very offensive slang): a person with dark skin *You could get into serious trouble if you say the word "nigger".*

Chink (noun – very offensive slang): a person from China *Some idiot on the train called an Asian girl a Chink.*

ignorant (adjective): lacking knowledge, or unaware of something *If you don't follow the news, you'll be a very ignorant person.*

ignore (verb): to not pay attention to something or someone *If people stare at you, just try to ignore them.*

racist (adjective): of the belief that one race is superior to another *Three black kids were beaten up in a racist attack in London.*

kick out (phrasal verb - informal): to force someone to leave *My sister was kicked out of school for bullying other kids.*

piss off (phrasal verb – British slang): to annoy or anger someone *Doesn't it piss you off when banks increase the fees they charge?*

fit (adjective – British slang): sexually attractive *Did Jason really say he thinks I'm fit?*

let go (phrasal verb): to allow someone or something to go free *After the police questioned Ben, they let him go.*
