Teaching Suggestions

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Activity 1

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- Put the students into pairs or small groups.
- 2. Get a student to read the instructions out loud and check that they are clear.
- 3. Let the students read the questions then deal with vocabulary gueries.
- 4. Give the students time to brainstorm vocabulary.
- 5. Let the students begin their conversation, speaking together in English.
- 6. Monitor.
- 7. Stop the activity.
- 8. Do some error correction.
- 9. Consolidate pronunciation.
